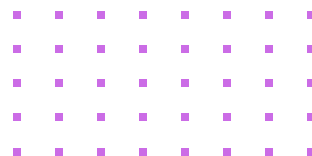

About Guest Speakers & Panellists

Tan Sri Ahmad Zaki Ansore Mohd Yusof

Tan Sri Ahmad Zaki Ansore Mohd Yusof was formerly the Director General of the Implementation and Coordination Unit, Prime Minister's Department (ICU-JPM). He was appointed into the position in 2015 and retired in 2019. He joined the Malaysian Public Service in 1983 and has served in various leadership roles at federal and state level. He holds a Bachelor Degree in Economics from University of Malaya and a Master's Degree in Policy Sciences from Saitama University in Japan and alumnus of RSOG. Tan Sri was the guest speaker for RSOG Customised Programme, "The Art of Leadership" in collaboration with Majlis Amanah Rakyat (MARA) on 11 Nov 2021 and with Immigration Department of Malaysia from 23-24 March 2022.

Dr Hezri Adnan

Dr Hezri Adnan is presently the Executive Director of the Malaysian Institute of Economic Research. Before joining the Institute, he served as the Chief Executive Officer of the Langkawi Development Authority (LADA, a statutory body under the Ministry of Finance) and Chairman of several its tourism business subsidiaries. He is currently an Adjunct Professor at the University of Malaya and previously at the Universiti Tenaga Nasional and Universiti Teknologi Malaysia. Dr Hezri has also held visiting positions abroad at Kyoto University and the Australian National University. The latter is his alma mater, where he obtained his PhD in Public Policy in 2006. Hezri was elected a Fellow of the Academy of Sciences Malaysia in 2016. Dr Hezri has also served as a Distinguished Fellow at the Institute of Strategic and International Studies (ISIS). Dr Hezri specialises in sustainable development solutions with work spanning areas such as the green economy and natural resources governance. He has consulted for international organisation such as UNDP, UNESCAP, UNICEF, UNRISD and the World Bank on many issues related to the development and ESG investing challenges in the developing world. From 2015 to 2018, Hezri served as a Member of the United Nations' International Resource Panel (IRP), a UN Environment Programme expert body that focuses on strategic issues of resource scarcity and efficiency. His past and current advisory roles include Cleared Advisor for the Malaysian Ministry of International Trade and Industries, Board Member of the Penang Green Council and a Member of the Advisory Council for WWF Malaysia. Dr Hezri has authored more than 100 publications. His most recent book is "The Sustainability Shift: Refashioning Malaysia's Future" and a report "An Overview Study of Water Food Energy Nexus in Malaysia". He was the Guest Speaker at RSOG Seminar "Governance of Natural Resources : Problems & Prospects" on 6 November 2014 and RSOG Webinar "Into Thin Air" on 14 July 2020. He was also the Guest Panelist at RSOG-JPA Young Leaders Forum on 6 December 2018.
