The National Population and Family Development Board, the NPFDB, was established in 1966 under the Population and Family Development Act 1966 (Act 352) under the purview of the Prime Minister's Department. ### YM Tengku Nila Putri Tengku Ilham

Tengku Nila Putri is currently Senior Vice President, MTDC Academy, Malaysian Technology Development Corporation (MTDC). Attended her foundational schooling years at MGS Klang before pursuing her Diploma in Business Studies at UiTM Dungun, Terengganu and Masters of Management Post Degree Programme at a local University. Due to her interest in Business, she went on to study at Drake University in Des Moines, Iowa where she majored in Marketing under the School of Business. Tengku Nila possesses a wealth of knowledge and skills in branding and marketing, having been attached to numerous Multinational Corporations such as The Body Shop, Danone-Dumex, F&N Dairies, Colgate-Palmolive, Dutch Lady and the French Groupe-SEB. She held various portfolios from brand management to medical marketing and commercialization initiatives in Malaysia and other regional countries including Singapore, Brunei and Hong Kong. Tengku Nila is a Council Member of the Institute of Marketing Malaysia. A certified trainer (HRDF) under the purview of the Ministry of Human Resources, Malaysia, she provides marketing training, business communication, and advisory services for start-ups and Small and Medium Enterprises (SME's). ### Professor Dr. Wan Mohd Nor Wan Daud

Professor Dr. Wan Mohd Nor Wan Daud is the founder-director of Center for Advanced Studies on Islam, Science and Civilisation (CASIS), Universiti Teknologi Malaysia. After obtaining his doctorate from the University of Chicago under the late Fazlur Rahman in 1988, he was invited by Syed Muhammad Naquib al-Attas to assist him at the newly established International Institute of Islamic Thought and Civilization (ISTAC) in all the formal and non-formal academic development including library, publication and student affairs. From 1998-2002 he served as the Deputy Director of ISTAC. From 2008 to February 2011, he served as Principal Research Fellow at the Institute of the Malay World and Civilisation (ATMA), Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia. Professor Wan Mohd Nor has written more than 15 books and monographs as well as more than 40 academic articles in local and international journals, of which the major ones are: The Concept of Knowledge in Islam: Its Implication for Education in a Developing Country (1989); A Commentary on the Culture of Knowledge (Malay) (1990); The Educational Philosophy and Practice of Syed Muhammad Naquib al-Attas: An Exposition of the Original Concept of Islamization (1998); Development in Malaysia: Towards a Holistic Understanding (Malay) (2000); 2 books of philosophical-mystical Malay poetry (2003 and 2004); Hadhari Muslim Society: An Epistemological and Educational Approach Towards National Unity (Malay) (2006); a book coauthored with Syed Muhammad Naquib al-Attas, The ICLIF Leadership Competency Model: An Islamic Alternative (2007); a book co-edited with Muhammad Zainiy Uthman, Knowledge, Language, Thought and The Civilization of Islam: Essays in Honor of Syed Muhammad Naquib al-Attas (UTM, 2010). Several of his books, articles and monographs have been translated into Malay, Indonesian, Turkish, Japanese, Persian, Russian, Bosnian and Macedonian. Professor Dr. Wan Mohd Nor was the Guest Speaker at RSOG Seminar "The Meaning and Limits of Tolerance" on 28 February 2014.

### Dato' Faris Yahaya

Dato' Faris Yahaya is the Group Chief Executive Officer - Designate, MK Land Holdings Berhad and was formerly the Group CEO of ORANGEBEAM.
